

WARNING

In case of an EARTHQUAKE:

- **DO NOT RUSH OUT OF THE BUILDING.**
(An earthquake usually consists of a series of repeated and intermittent tremors, during which it is advisable to remain still inside the building or near a shelter rather than moving around or using stairways.)

- **SEEK SHELTER UNDER DESKS, TABLES, DOOR FRAMES, OR NEAR LOAD-BEARING WALLS.**

- **STAY AWAY FROM WINDOWS, GLASS DOORS, CABINETS, STAIRWELLS, AND ELEVATORS.**

Seek shelter under desks, tables, or door frames, or near load-bearing walls.
Stay away from windows, glass doors, cabinets, stairwells, and elevators.

- **Once the tremors have stopped, proceed with evacuation using only the stairs, avoiding elevators.**

(Walk carefully, testing the floor, steps, and landings before proceeding. Step carefully without putting your full weight down immediately.)

- After leaving the building, go to the designated "Assembly Point" and CALL:

- **Supervision:** → **050 3152023**
(internal number 2023)

- If no response:

- **Security Guards:** → **050 3152213** (internal number 2213)

- If none of the above numbers respond, call:

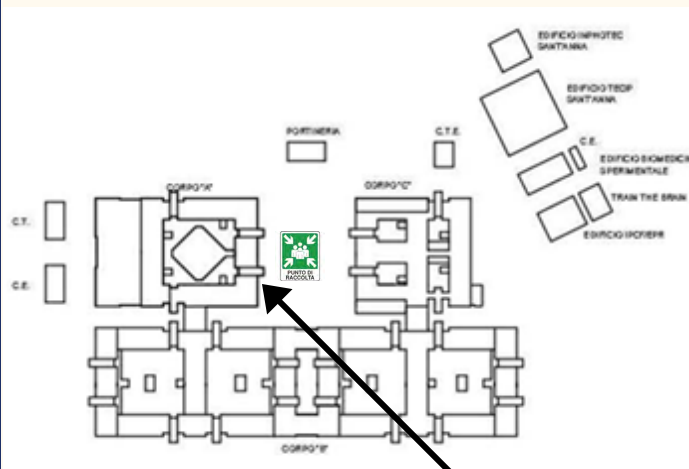
- **Firefighters:** → **112**

REPORTING:

- THE TYPE OF EMERGENCY, THE LOCATION, AND ANY INJURED PEOPLE.

FOR ANY TYPE OF EMERGENCY, AVOID TAKING ACTION UNLESS SAFETY CONDITIONS HAVE BEEN VERIFIED IN ADVANCE!

BEHAVIORAL RULES IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

WARNING

Anyone who detects an **EMERGENCY** such as smoke, fire, spills of substances, flooding, or any situation of potential danger,

MUST IMMEDIATELY LEAVE THE AUDITORIUM

☎ **Supervision 050 3152023** (internal extension 2023)

☎ If there is no answer: **Security Guards 050 3152213** (internal extension 2213)

🚫 **NOTE:** In case none of the above numbers respond, call the **FIRE DEPARTMENT** at **115**, providing:

- Type of emergency
- Location involved
- Presence of any injured persons

👉 **TAKE ACTION**
(Only within the limits of your own personal safety), with the help of others, to contain or limit damage caused or potentially caused by the emergency.

👉 **FOLLOW**
The instructions given by the emergency team and/or the Fire Department.

WARNING DURING EVACUATION



- ✓ **DO NOT** delay to retrieve personal belongings, assist anyone in difficulty
- ✓ **DO NOT** create panic situations (do not shout, do not push, do not run)
- ✓ **ONLY USE THE EVACUATION ROUTES** until reaching the nearest emergency exit (unless otherwise indicated by digital emergency alerts or Fire Department personnel)
- ✓ **DO NOT** use elevators: if smoke is present, crawl and cover your respiratory passages with a cloth (preferably damp)

Assess the Situation

Ensure your safety, assess the scene, and call for professional help if needed before rendering aid.

WARNING - ONCE OUTSIDE

- 📌 Go directly to the assembly point.



DO NOT CREATE CONFUSION

- ✓ Respond promptly if called during headcount
- ✓ Report any missing persons to the emergency team and/or the Fire Department
- ✓ Avoid obstructing emergency and rescue operations

if available.

Heat and Cold Emergencies

Learn to recognize and respond to heat-related illnesses such as heatstroke and cold-related conditions like hypothermia.

FIRST AID

SOS IN CASE OF ACCIDENT OR ILLNESS:

☎ Immediately call **112** and follow the instructions given by the operations center. ☎ Afterwards, call **050 3152023** (or, if unavailable, **050 3152213**) to report the incident.

- ♦ **DO NOT** move the injured person, but stay with them and try to keep them calm until rescue personnel arrive.

🚫 **DO NOT** give drinks or anything else to the patient, and try to make the surrounding environment as comfortable and safe as possible. Avoid crowding around the injured person.
